Amber Valley CVS Befriending Service ...

has run since 1998. The aims of the service are to provide companionship and support for socially isolated people.

What does a befriender do?

- Volunteer to visit someone once a week
- Provide companionship and support

What support do we offer your Befriender?

- Training
- Travel expenses
- Drop in sessions



All of our volunteers are CRB checked to ensure they are trustworthy and safe to enter your home

We recognise that social isolation can occur for a variety of reasons and accept referrals for people who are elderly, have learning difficulties or a mental health problem.

Your referral will have been made to the scheme by :

 A professional involved in your care, e.g. social worker, care worker, doctor or a family member.

What next?

After this visit, if you wish to join the scheme, we will:

- Identify a potential befriender for you
- Introduce the volunteer to you
- Contact you and the volunteer to ensure you are both happy with the match
- Send a letter confirming the date and time of your befrienders visit




